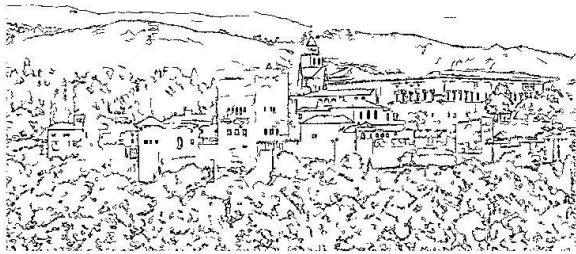

Where is Granada and what is the Alhambra?

Granada is a city in the south of Spain, in the region called Andalucia. It is a lively city with nice buildings but it is especially famous because of the Alhambra.

The word Alhambra means the Red One. The very first building work done there was over 1000 years ago, in the year 889, to make a small fortress where there had been some remains of Roman times.

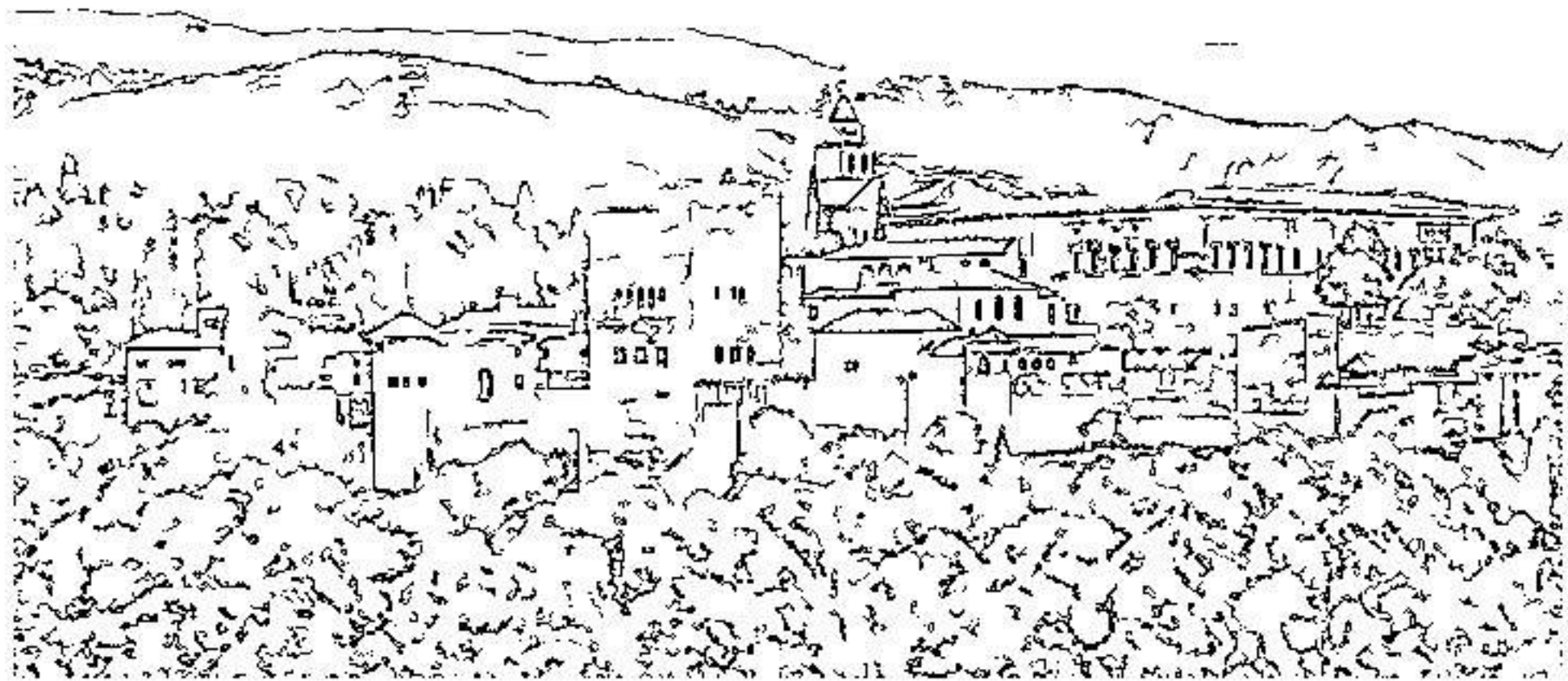
Not much happened for a few centuries then, until the middle of the 13th century, when the Moorish monarch, Nasrid emir Mohammed ben Al-Ahmar, who was the Emirate of Granada, built the palace and walls that can be seen today.

Then over the centuries things changed and by 1492 after the Christian Reconquest, the Alhambra became the Royal Court for the then King and Queen of Spain, Ferdinand and Isabella.

Because the Alhambra is so impressive and beautiful, it becomes incredibly busy with tourists. You and your parents need to book before to see it and even then you will have to wait for a while to be able to enter.
